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MANY HANDS COOK BOOK

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BEAN NACHOS

This is a pretty quick and easy meal that always gets gobbled-up by the family. - Shuttlewell Family

INGREDIENTS	METHOD
1 packet of nacho spice mix	Heat some oil in a large pan to a moderate heat and fry the onion until soft. Add the carrot and cook for another 4 or 5 minutes.
1 onion finely chopped	
1 large carrot finely diced	Add the spice mix and garlic and stir. Cook for another minute. Add the capsicum, tomatoes, mixed beans, tomato paste, stock cubes and Worcestershire sauce and simmer for at least 15 minutes.
1 capsicum chopped	
2 cloves garlic finely diced	Season with salt and pepper to taste. Add the sweetcorn and cook until everything is tender.
2 400g tins diced tomato's	
2 400g tins of mixed beans	
2 tbsp tomato paste	
2 beef or vegetarian stock cubes	
1 tbsp Worcestershire sauce (approximately)	Serve with corn-chips, cut up fresh tomato, cucumber and avocado, grated cheese and sour cream. Chippotle sauce optional.
2 cups of frozen sweetcorn	My husband adds bacon in at the beginning for extra flavour and likes to serve it with spring onions.
Salt and pepper to taste	All measurements are approximate and to taste.

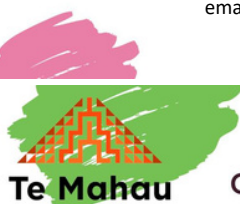
