Attendance - Term 3

Our Term 3 Attendance results were once again lower than is desired.

The Government has as one of its Education Priorities; improving attendance.

"In April 2024, the Government announced a regular attendance target of **80** percent of students to be present for more than 90% of the term by 2030."

We are a long way from reaching that target;

In term 3 only **36%** of our students attended 90% of the time.

52% of those absent were away for medical reasons 34% of those absent were away for a holiday within term time

8% of those absent were away for a justified reasons, within school policy

6% of those absent were explained but not for a justified reason within school policy.

There seems to have been an incredible amount of students who have had a holiday within term time this year. This does make it challenging for teachers planning learning experiences, and having children missing for part of it. The Art Exhibition was an example of this. We have also noticed some children who had time of school for holidays, then needed additional support to catch up their learning. Please consider the learning cost, if you are planning an overseas trip next year.




