The Funky Fish Event is almost here!

Pick up your entry tickets from Parua Bay GAS, Burnsco, the Eventbrite website or from the cash tent on the day of the event - just remember you do need your ticket ready for photographing with your catch-and-release entries!

Keep an eye out for the competition code for catch-and-release, which will be announced at 1pm on Saturday on the website and the Funky Fish website - funkyfishing.co.nz

Funky Fish Rules

This year we are making this fishing competition more sustainable, by increasing the number of catch-and-release categories.

These are some other noteworthy changes to keep in mind:

- This year we are only accepting Snapper between 30-55cm in length for "length based measurement" at the event. All Snapper longer than 55cm must be entered in to the Catch and Release category.
- Maximum of 1 kahawai per person presented for length based measurement. This must be bled prior.
- Maximum of 3 fish per category John Dory, Kingfish, Trevally, Snapper, except Kahawai (see rule 4 above) are to be presented for length based measurement at the event.
- There is no limit to the number of catch and release entries per person/ticket holder.

All Proceeds Fundraised During the Funky Fishing & Diving Event Go Towards Supporting Whangarei Heads School & Community Library


Competition Code
