

WHANGAREI HEADS SCHOOL

ENROLMENT SCHEME



To avoid overcrowding, or the likelihood of overcrowding, the Board of Whangarei Heads School implemented an enrolment scheme, developed by the Secretary of Education, beginning on 24th July 2024.

Under this scheme, the students will be enrolled if they live within the home zone described below.

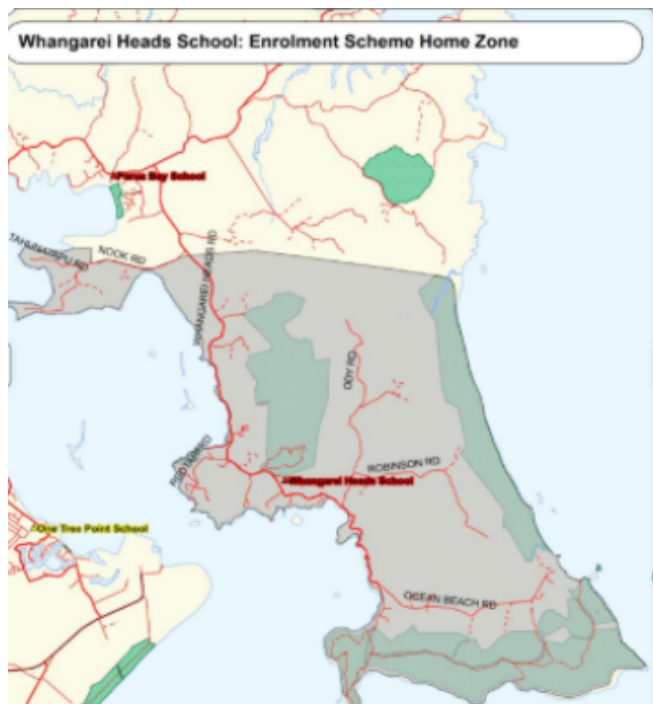
The Home Zone includes addresses on both sides of the boundary roads mentioned in the description, and all no-exit roads off the boundary roads are included in the zone unless otherwise stated.

The zone starts at Bream Head and travels north along the coastline to Ocean Beach. The zone then travels west along Ocean Beach Road to include all connecting streets and roads (i.e. Ranui Road, Breakers Lane, Peach Cove Track, Capey Lane, Basil Road) and then turns north into Whangarei Heads Road from the Urquhart Bay Road intersection.

Urquhart Bay Road is included as is Calliope Lane and Lion View Road. The zone travels north along Whangarei Heads Road to include all addresses in the Taurikura and Whangarei Heads settlements. The zone continues north along Whangarei Heads Road up to Nook Road and includes all connecting streets/roads (1641 Whangarei Heads Road is excluded).

The zone travels west along Nook Road to the west coast (excluding 74 and 182 Nook Road), with Tahumatapu Road addresses included in-zone.

From the Nook Road/Whangarei Heads Road intersection, the zone travels east across country to Kauri Mountain Beach at the coast and travels south along the coastline back to Ocean Beach.



What about my New Entrant child who is a sibling of an existing student in 2024?

If you have a pre-schooler, and had older siblings enrolled at WHS on the 22 July 2024, they are considered an “in zone” child, regardless of your address. This is referred to as being the Grandparent Clause.

The enrolment for out-of-zone students is governed by the provisions of the Education and Training Act 2020.

What about if we live out of the zone, but wish to enrol at WHS?

Each year the Board will consider the number of in zone whanau intending to enroll and allocate some out of zone places via Ballot. They will also determine the number of ballots to be held in a school year.

This process will be advertised in the Whangarei Heads/Parua Bay Facebook Page, the Whangarei Heads School Facebook Page and the community newsletter. The notice will state how many places will be available the following year, and details of when to have your pre-enrolment for the next ballot.
